CANDIDATE ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS	DEADLINE TO FILE CANDIDATE APPLICATION
<p><i>Filing requirements are per state statute, available at https://www.sos.state.tx.us/elections/candidates/guide/local.shtml, and those of the Election Code:</i></p> <ol style="list-style-type: none">MUST be a United States CitizenMUST be at least 18 years of age or older on the commencement of the term filled at the electionMUST be a registered voter of the City of Jefferson.(MAYOR) MUST have resided continuously in the state for twelve (12) months prior to filing deadline and twelve (12) months in the city prior to election day. (Texas Elec. Code, Section 22.032 and 141.001) (Alderman/Alderwomen) MUST have resided continuously in the state for twelve (12) months and six (6) months in the city (ward) prior to filing deadline. (Texas Elec. Code, Section 141.001(a); Brown v. Patterson, 609 SW 2nd 287)5. MUST NOT have been finally convicted of a felony (unless pardoned or otherwise released from the resulting disabilities.MUST NOT be under an adjudication of mental incompetence.MUST satisfy any other requirement prescribed by law for the office.	<p align="center">Applications for a place on the ballot for the May 4, 2024 Election will be accepted starting Wednesday, January 17, 2024 during regular business hours, Monday through Friday from 8:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m. The last day to file for a place on the ballot is Friday, February 16, 2024.</p>
